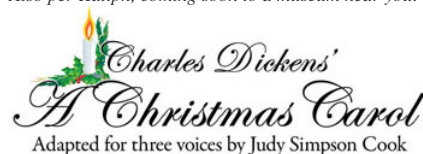
Around Town

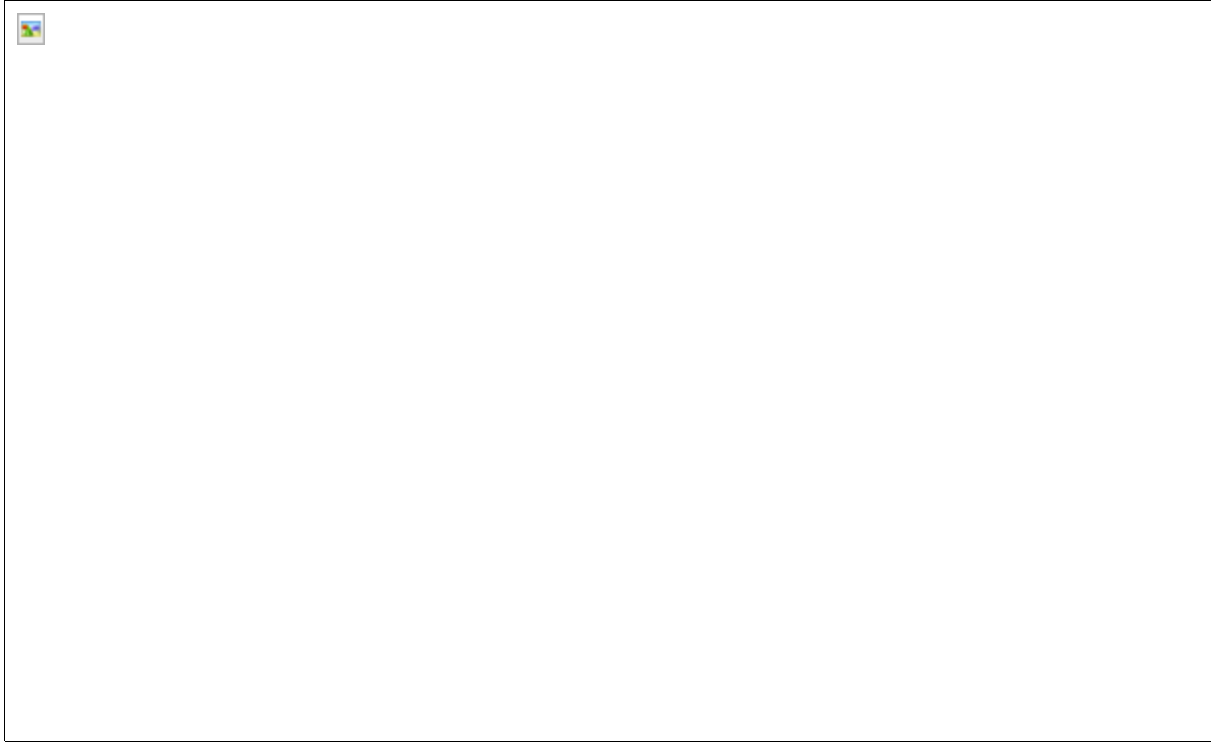
